FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR ABORTION IN OUEENSLAND

Children by Choice has been providing financial assistance to help disadvantaged Queenslanders access abortion since 2000. The need for this program has grown significantly since its inception and in the 2015-16 financial year totalled over \$90,000.


This assistance consists of grants from our service which women do not have to repay, no interest loans administered by us (in a scheme started thanks to some startup capital from a philanthropic grant fund), support from other community organisations (including youth, homelessness, and violence services), and discounted procedures from abortion providers.

None of the funds we provide come from government funding. All the grants we supply are made possible by donations from members and supporters, who have the grateful thanks of our team and our clients.

Financial assistance is disproportionately accessed by the following groups:

- Those in the Metro South Health and Hospital Service district (36% of all funds in 2015):
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander women (18%): and
- Those experiencing domestic and/or sexual violence (44%).
