

# Reproductive Rights and Abortion Conference 2026 **Overview**

Children by Choice's Reproductive Rights and Abortion Conference 2026 is the only conference in Australia dedicated solely to abortion, reproductive rights and bodily autonomy. Our conference brings together healthcare professionals, researchers, advocates, community and private organisations, working across abortion and reproductive healthcare. 




#### **DELEGATES BY LOCATION**



 These Terms and Conditions apply from the date of signing. You acknowledge that Children by Choice reserves the right to change or amend the details of the exhibition.

#### **OUR OBLIGATIONS AND ENTITLEMENTS**

#### We will:

- Plan, coordinate and deliver the conference.
- Promote the exhibition to potential participants and attendees.
- o Make reasonable efforts to allocate the space you have requested.
- Provide full venue details, bump-in times, and all relevant conference information by 17 August 2026.

#### We do not:

- Guarantee specific attendee numbers or any particular level of commercial engagement during the exhibition.
- Guarantee approval of your application

#### We may alter aspects of the exhibition, including but not limited to:

- Adjusting your allocated space or relocating it to meet floor plan requirements and reducing your fee proportionately if the size decreases.
- · Changing the overall exhibition duration.
- · Changing opening hours for attendees.
- Expanding the exhibition area into an additional space separate from the primary venue.

#### We ask that you:

- Follow all applicable laws and regulations.
- · Avoid causing damage to the venue, any persons, or property.

#### We may:

- o Refuse or stop displays, demonstrations, or any use of your space that we consider inappropriate.
- Set requirements for wall heights, coverings, and display standards.
- Approve or reject the content and presentation of your promotional materials.
- o Decide the times you can install or remove your display.
- Manage the way you, your staff, contractors, and representatives use exhibitor entry passes.
- Set rules for moving displays, products, and goods before, during, and after the exhibition.
- o Apply restrictions on photography if required and notify you if this is needed.
- Specify how audio visual equipment may be used and how machinery may be demonstrated.
- Establish health and safety requirements.
