

Reproductive Rights and Abortion Conference 2026 Overview

Children by Choice's Reproductive Rights and Abortion Conference 2026 is the only conference in Australia dedicated solely to abortion, reproductive rights and bodily autonomy. Our conference brings together healthcare professionals, researchers, advocates, community and private organisations – working across abortion and reproductive healthcare. For sponsors, this is a rare opportunity to position your organisation at the centre of a national conversation shaping the future of abortion and reproductive healthcare.

For the first time, we're expanding our conference to three days – with two full days dedicated to research, community health initiatives/projects and advocacy, and an exciting new Clinical Education Day where **AHRPA registered** healthcare practitioners can build vital skills in providing abortion care and contraceptive methods.

Across the three inspiring days, delegates will engage with plenary addresses, panels, and interactive breakout sessions, covering the most pressing issues in abortion and reproductive healthcare. Consistent with past years, we anticipate over 300 delegates, including:

- doctors and health practitioners from both public and private sectors
- allied health professionals
- leaders from NGOs and community organisations
- academics, researchers, and students

Our 2026 keynote lineup is our most exciting yet — **Carly Findlay** and **Yumi Stynes** will each bring unique perspectives on inclusion, culture, and reproductive justice. Their voices will spark ideas, challenge assumptions, and inspire action.






DELEGATES BY LOCATION

From what started as five women joining together to advocate for abortion in Queensland that then grew into a movement, Beryl Holmes was a brilliant and transformational force in the fabric of Australian feminism. Her work to create an organisation that listened to the needs of women and ensure that bodily autonomy was maintained has paved the way, almost 60 years later, to the rights and freedoms we have today.




